1. St. Augustine’s College was founded in 1930 by the Catholic Church in Ghana.

2. **FEES:**

- a. All fees are to be paid by Bank Draft or Payment Order made payable to the Headmaster, St. Augustine’s College, Cape Coast with the students name and class clearly written at the back. No Cash payments are acceptable.

- b. **SCHOLARSHIP**

No student shall hold more than one public-Government Scholarship in the College

In the event of a student having more than one such scholarship, the parent/guardian shall write to opt for one; failure to do so, the College shall reserve the right to choose on behalf of the parent.

The other scholarship may be given to a student who may stand in need or refunded to the awarding body/company/agency.

Parents/Guardians shall pay fees of student on scholarship that has been delayed in payment by the awarding body/company/agency to the College.

- c. **REFUND OF FEES**

Credit balance standing in favour of the student shall only be paid at the end of the student’s course of stay in the College. The request for such refund shall be made in writing by the PARENT and **NOT** the STUDENT

3. **VISIT**

Students are allowed visitors every Saturday from 12.00noon to 5.00pm. Parents and visitors are advised to keep to this time. Visitors are NOT allowed on week days and Sundays.

4. **HEALTH**

There is a qualified health professional in charge of the College clinic and a visiting doctor. All health problems must be referred to the clinic. Request for further treatment outside the College

shall be made through the College nurses, who will liaise with the College's authorities. When the need arises parents/guardians will be invited by College's authorities to come for their sick ward/child who require treatment outside the College

5. **COLLEGE KIT**

Parents/Guardians are advised to ensure that students do not bring to the College unprescribed kit. This will be confiscated and shall not be returned No electrical or electronic gadget or equipment except electric pressing iron is allowed in the College. Parents are to warn their wards not to tamper with electrical or plumbing installations in the College.

6. **CELL PHONES:**

Under no circumstances shall a student bring to the College cell Phone(s). this will be confiscated and NOT returned

7. **APPEARANCE**

All students are to wear their hair very low. Students are not allowed to wear beard and/or mustache. Tattoos, perforation of ear lobes, etc are not allowed.

Parents should ensure that their wards are decently dressed.

8. **GUIDANCE AND COUNSELLING**

There is a guidance and counseling department manned by capable staff. Students are encouraged to make use of this department and its staff to help them solve or overcome their difficulties.

9. **P.T.A.**

Parents/Guardians are automatic members of this association once their wards are enrolled in the College. They are encouraged to participate meaningfully in the affairs of the association.

10. **WITHDRAWAL AND TRANSFER FROM THE COLLEGE**

(a). **From the College:-** Parents/Guardians must give at least a term's notice of withdrawal/transfer of their ward from the College in writing, failing this their term's fees must be paid

(b). **From the Boarding House**

A parent may write to request for boarding accommodation or give up a boarding accommodation with at least a terms notice in writing failing this the term's fees must be paid.

Request by STUDENTS to be considered for boarding facility or to leave the boarding house shall not be considered

11. **COLLEGE ACTIVITIES**

All students are to attend and participate in all College activities, including the Dining Hall even if the student is not hungry.

12. **CHANGE OF NAME**

The name of the student, on admission to the College shall remain the same throughout the period of the students stay in the College. Request for a change of name shall not be granted

13. **CHANGE OF PROGRAMME/SUBJECT**

Students have been admitted based on their choices or programmes at the BECE. Request for the change of programme or subject shall not be considered once admitted

14. **STAFF RESIDENCE**

Staff residence is out of bounds to all students at all times

15. **EXAMINATIONS**

1. Students promotion at the end of every academic year is based on good performance. A student may be asked to repeat or withdraw, where repetition would not be of help.
2. Registration and writing of the WASSCE at the end of the four (4) year course will only be confirmed where the student has justified good academic ability and preparation.
3. Parents and students must take note then, that writing the final WAEC examination as a College candidate is not **automatic** but dependent on the College conviction that the student is well prepared
4. In view of this, writing of examinations at the College is very keen and no malpractice is tolerated.
5. Students are not allowed to register and write the NOV/DEC Private candidates Examination as a student of the College
6. Non-performing students stand the chance of being repeated.

16. **DEFACING/ DESTRUCTION OF COLLEGE PROPERTY**

1. **Writing on walls:** Students who write on the walls will be made to pay for paint, brushes and workmanship to repaint the place
2. **Breaking of Louvre blades:** Students who break Louvre blades will be made to pay **three times** the cost.
3. **Breaking of desk:** Students who break desk will be made to pay **three times** the cost.
